SUBJECT: 25% Tariffs on Steel Products Implemented by the Government of Canada

Dear Valued Customer,

On November 26, 2025, the Government of Canada announced that tariffs may be introduced on certain steel imports. This was confirmed on December 12, 2025, with a 25% tariff to be applied to select steel-derivative products for goods in transit on or after December 26, 2025. The tariff applies to a range of steel products, with some exclusions. Please see the link below for additional details.

Affected Products:

- **Fasteners and similar items** (Nails, screws, bolts, nuts, rivets, cotters, cotter pins, washers, and similar fasteners)
- **Steel wire, rods, and mesh** (Wire rods, drawn wire, coils, and wire mesh)
- **Steel structures and parts** (Structural steel and other parts of iron or steel)
- **Plastic and polymer-based items** (Plates, sheets, film, foil, and strips of plastics)
- **Other metal items / special articles** (Stainless or other iron/steel articles, fittings, and hardware)
- **Prefabricated buildings and related structures** (Prefabricated buildings, parts, and related structures (including air-supported buildings))

Please note that these tariffs are imposed by the Government of Canada and will be invoiced to us as the importer of record at customs upon entry into Canada. We can assure you that this change will not have an immediate impact on our current pricing. However, as products are placed in transit by ocean after December 26, future landed costs for the affected product categories will be impacted on a rolling basis. Some items that move faster than others will be impacted sooner, with pricing reflecting the new tariffs accordingly.

This change affects all of us, regardless of the industry. We remain committed to working closely with you to manage and transition through these changes, and to provide the necessary support as we navigate them together.
